

BY-LAW NO. 27/88

A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ISLAND LAKE SOUTH,  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO REGULATE HIGHWAY TRAFFIC  
WITHIN THE SUMMER VILLAGE.

PURSUANT to the authority vested in it by the provision  
of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.A. 1980 and admendments  
thereto, the Council of the Summer Village of Island Lake  
South duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

1. That the Council of the Summer Village of Island Lake  
South may authorize the placing, erecting or marking of  
traffic control devices at such locations as are considered  
necessary for controlling highways subject to its control  
and management.

PARKING

1. No person shall park or leave any vehicle on private  
land or property that has been clearly marked as such by  
a sign or signs erected by the owner or his agent, unless  
such a person has obtained the permission of the owner,  
tenant, occupant or person in charge or control of said  
land or property.

AUTHORITY TO ENFORCE

1. A peace officer, or other person as may be authorized  
by the Council of the Summer Village of Island Lake South  
shall be empowered to remove or cause to be removed, any  
vehicle or trailer.

2. Any expense of the removal will be charged to the  
registered owner of the vehicle or trailer.

This by-law shall come into force on the date of the  
third and final reading.

READ a first time this 8th day of October, 1988.

READ a second time this 8th day of October, 1988.

READ a third and final time this 8th day of October, 1988.
