

BY-LAW NO. 4/83

A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ISLAND LAKE SOUTH,  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, RELATING TO THE BAN ON  
CAMPING IN PARKS AND ON RESERVE LANDS.


UNDER THE AUTHORITY of and pursuant to the provisions  
of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1980 and  
amendments thereto, and the Planning Act, R.S.A. 1980  
and amendments thereto, the Council of the Summer  
Village of Island Lake South enacts as follows:

1. That all reserve lands within the Summer Village  
are designated as parks.
2. That no camping shall be permitted on Summer Village  
parks at any time.
3. That all Summer Village parks are closed to the  
public from 11:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. each day.
4. That any person who contravenes this by-law is  
guilty of an offence and liable to summary  
conviction of a penalty of:
  - (a) \$35.00 for the first offence
  - (b) \$75.00 for the second and subsequent offences  
which fine shall be imposed by a Court upon  
conviction for a contravention of this by-law.
5. This by-law comes into effect upon the date of its  
final passing.

READ a first time this 21st day of January, 1983.

READ a second time this 21st day of January, 1983.

READ a third and final time this 21st day of January, 1983.
