

BY-LAW NO. 6/83

A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ISLAND LAKE SOUTH,
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR A GENERAL
PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER
VILLAGE.

UNDER THE AUTHORITY of and pursuant to the provisions
of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1980 and
amendments thereto, the council of the Summer Village
of Island Lake South enacts as follows:


1. That any person who violates any provision
of any by-law of the Summer Village of Island Lake
South shall be guilty of an offence and liable on
Summary Conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$2,500.00
or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding 6 months
where the fines and costs, including the costs of
committal, are not sooner paid.
2. This by-law shall not apply to any by-law of the
Summer Village of Island Lake South where a specific
penalty is stated therein.
3. This by-law shall come into force on the date of the
third and final reading.

READ a first time this 21st day of January, 1983.

READ a second time this 21st day of January, 1983.

READ a third and final time this 21st day of January, 1983.
