SUMMER VILLAGE OF ISLAND LAKE SOUTH

IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BY-LAW NO. 65/2000

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ISLAND LAKE SOUTH TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ASSESSOR AS A DESIGNATED OFFICER.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1, Statutes of Alberta 1994 are as follows:

"A Council may by by-law establish one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties and functions of a designated officer under this or any other enactment of by-law".

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 284 (d) (ii), of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1 Statutes of Alberta 1994, defines as follows:

"assessor means a person appointed by a municipality to the position of designated officer to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an assessor under this Act, and includes any person to whom those duties and responsibilities are delegated by the person referred to in sub-clause (i) or (ii) of the above Section".

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Island Lake South duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:


1. That Raymond Crews, Municipal Assessment Services Group Inc. be appointed as a designated officer to carry out the duties and responsibilities of Municipal Assessor.
2. That this By-Law shall take full force and effect upon third and final reading and upon signing in accordance with Section 213, Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1, Statutes of Alberta 1994.

READ a second time this 20th day of January, 2000.

READ a third and final time this 20th day of January, 2000.
