SUMMER VILLAGE OF ISLAND LAKE SOUTH

BY-LAW 3-72/2002

BEING A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ISLAND LAKE SOUTH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REGULATE THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL LIMITS OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, the Summer Village of Island Lake South has concerns regarding the discharge of firearms within the Municipal limits and;

WHEREAS, the discharge of firearms within the Summer Village limits may cause a serious injury and;

WHEREAS, if firearms are not permitted to be discharged within the Summer Village this will prevent a serious injury from occurring;

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act the council of the Summer Village of Island Lake South, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts as follows:

No person being otherwise lawfully authorized shall discharge any rifle, shotgun, airgun or other firearm within the limits of the Municipality of Island Lake South.

That this by-law shall be effective, on and from the date of final passing.
