

BYLAW NO. 80-06

**A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ISLAND LAKE SOUTH  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA  
TO REPEAL THE ISLAND LAKE AREA STRUCTURE PLAN BYLAW,  
BYLAW NO. 97-1981 OF THE COUNTY OF ATHABASCA  
AS IT AFFECTS ISLAND LAKE SOUTH**

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, as amended ("the Act") authorizes the Council to establish, amend, and repeal an Area Structure Plan;

WHEREAS, prior to the establishment of the Summer Village of Island Lake South, the County of Athabasca No. 12 adopted the Island Lake Area Structure Plan, which affected the lands which became the Summer Village of Island Lake South;

WHEREAS since the establishment of the Summer Village of Island Lake South, the Island Lake Area Structure Plan has not been modified by the Council of the Summer Village;


WHEREAS, in 2002, the County of Athabasca No. 12 repealed the Island Lake Area Structure Plan as it affected what was then the County of Athabasca;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Summer Village of Island Lake South has determined that the Island Lake Area Structure Plan as it affects the Summer Village of Island Lake South should also be repealed;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Island Lake South, duly assembled, enacts as follows:


