

**BY-LAW NUMBER: 96-14**

**A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ISLAND LAKE SOUTH  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA  
TO ESTABLISH A LANDFILL CHARGE**

WHEREAS the Athabasca Waste Management Commission Board charges a yearly fee to the Summer Village of Island Lake South for the use of the landfill;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality wishes to authorize charging the land owners of the Summer Village a per lot fee to recover this charge;

AND WHEREAS Section 7(f) and (g) of the Municipal Government Act Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26 provides for the passing of a by-law by a Municipal Council for the matter of public utilities,

AND WHEREAS Waste Management is defined as a Public Utility.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ISLAND LAKE SOUTH, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


There shall be levied on each property a landfill fee. This amount of this fee is to be set annually be a resolution of council and will appear as a separate item on the property tax bill.

This By-law comes into force on the day it is finally passed.

Read a first time this 15th day of December, A.D., 2014.

Read a second time this 15<sup>th</sup> day of December, A.D., 2014.

**Read a third time and finally passed this 23rd day of April A.D., 2015.**
