## Boat Launch

The boat launch is in need of some repairs. We plan to pull the current broken concrete out of the lake and put down concrete slats chained together. We are not able to do this work until we receive environmental approvals. In the meantime, use caution while loading and unloading boats. There is a steep drop off in the water if you back up too far.

### **Development Permits**

Just a reminder that the Summer Village requires development permits for all construction projects. The province of Alberta requires that any construction be completed in accordance with the Safety Codes Act. You must have permits for all gas, plumbing, heating, electrical and building construction. You also need a permit for any demolition project or any clearing that may affect the contour of the land.
