### **Annual General Meeting**

#### **Emergency Contact**

Please make sure that administration has your current information including an email address and phone number for notification in the event of an emergency. If your email and phone number are not shown on your tax notice, we do not have them.

#### Dogs

This is a reminder to all residents that dogs are not permitted to be off leash when off of your property and your dogs are not permitted to wander on to your neighbors property without their permission. There are strict fines for breaking this rules. Owners are also responsible for picking up after their dogs. Dangerous Incidents with dogs should be reported directly to the RCMP. Other dog issues should be reported to administration.

#### **Boat Launch**

The boat launch is in rough shape. With water levels being so low the drop off is more dangerous than ever. We will be putting a barricade on one side to direct vehicles away from the drop off. Use at your own risk. We do finally have provincial approval to repair the boat launch but the work must be done between July 15 and September 15 for environmental reasons. The boat launch will be closed for repair sometime during this time period. In the meantime be cautious or use one of the other boat launches in the area.

### FireSmart Spring Clean-up

The Athabasca Regional Waste Management Services Commission (ARWMSC) is hosting a Free Yard Debris Disposal Program from May 20th to May 30th. Fees for disposing of yard debris including grass, leaves, branches and wood, will be waived at all Athabasca Regional Waste Transfer Stations. #### **Community Hall**

We are in the process of getting quotes for the addition to our community hall. The plan will basically double the size of the hall and may in the future include a larger patio. This work is expected to take place in the fall.

#### Land Use Bylaw

Please note that council has now passed the new land use bylaw and the old one is no longer in effect.

### Fertilizer and Herbicide Bylaw

A friendly reminder that council has passed a fertilizer and herbicide bylaw for the Summer Village. The Bylaw can be viewed on our website at www.myislandlakesouth.com. All chemical fertilizers and herbicides are strictly prohibited except in the case of noxious weeds as defined in the Weed Control Act.



### **Municipal Reserves**

All lots in the summer village have some municipal reserve next to them and trees can only be removed if they are dangerous. Please let us know if you see any dangerous trees on the reserves. No improvements of any nature can be placed on reserve land by the residents. Existing structures may be repaired only if a development permit is obtained.

DO NOT burn your garbage. Please take garbage to the landfill.

### **ATVs**

Remember to keep your ATVs on the roads and out of the ditch. Please respect your neighbors when passing other residences and keep a reasonable speed.

### **Development Permits**

Just a reminder that the Summer Village requires development permits for all construction projects. The province of Alberta requires that any construction be completed in accordance with the Safety Codes Act. You must have permits for all gas, plumbing, heating, electrical and building construction. You also need a permit for any demolition project or any clearing that may affect the contour of the land.
